A first-class hotel, private visits to the top producers and sumptuous dining await as you discover the prestigious wines, history and beauty of Burgundy. SUNDAY, Day 1 - Welcome to Burgundy! Pick up from Dijon Train Station and short transfer to Beaune. Check in to the charming and historic 4-star Hôtel de la Poste, then enjoy a private walking tour of Beaune, with expert Guide Colette Barbier, followed by a wine-tasting introduction to the Burgundy wine region, and a review of our itinerary for the week. Dinner tonight is at the excellent Aupres Du Clocher in Pommard.

MONDAY, Day 2 - After breakfast we visit the picturesque Chateau du Clos de Vougeot where once again expert Guide Colette Barbier shares her knowledge of this historic location. It's a short drive to our first wine tasting visit of the day, Domaine Faiveley in Nuits-Saint-Georges. Lunch will be at the Michelin 1-star restaurant, Le Charlemagne in nearby Pernand-Vergelesses. After lunch it's just a drive to the old cellars of Maison Louis Latour in Aloxe-Corton. Dinner tonight is at one of France's most beloved bistros, Ma Cuisine in Beaune, known for its traditional Burgundian dishes and sublime wine list.

TUESDAY, Day 3 - This morning, after breakfast, we have a private visit with Pierre and Guy Moine at La Ferme Du Poiset in the hamlet of Détain-et-Bruant situated 20 minutes west of Vosne-Romanee. The Moines are makers of some of the finest chevre cheese in France. Afterward, it's just a short drive to the northern fringe of Beaune and our first wine tasting at Maison Louis Jadot. Lunch today is at Le Gourmandin in the heart of Beaune. Our second tasting of the day finds us exploring the labyrinth of underground cellars and tasting at the historic Bouchard Père et Fils. Afterward, guests have the evening to themselves to explore Beaune and have dinner on their own with our recommendations. From bistros and bars à vins, to Michelin-starred addresses, try Le Caveau des Arches, Le Bénaton, Christophe Quéant, Caves Madeleine, Le Bistro de L'Hotel, or La Ciboulette.

WEDNESDAY, Day 4 - After breakfast, guests will have time to explore Beaune on their own, to peruse the open-air market in the Place de la Halle, or join in a guided tour of the Musée de l'Hôtel-Dieu led by Colette Barbier. Lunch will be on one's own today. At the appointed hour, we will gather for an afternoon tour and tasting at Beaune's historic Maison Joseph Drouhin. Dinner will find us enjoying the passionate Burgundian cuisine and remarkable wine offerings of Le Comptoir des Tontons.

THURSDAY, Day 5 - After a leisurely breakfast, we'll drive south to our first tasting at the firm of Olivier Leflaive in Puligny-Montrachet. Lunch today will be just steps away at the Michelin 1-star Le Montrachet. After lunch our final tasting of the tour combines Domaine du Château de Puligny-Montrachet, Maison DEux Montille Soeur et Frere and Domaine de Montille in Puligny-Montrachet. Gathering for our final night in Beaune, our farewell dinner is at the Michelin 1-star Le Jardin des Remparts.

FRIDAY, Day 6 - Early morning departure today for a shuttle back to the Dijon Rail station for trains to Paris or onward travel.
